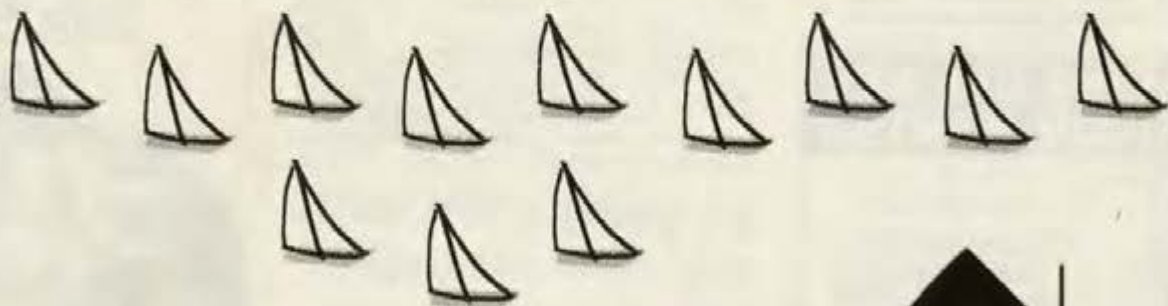
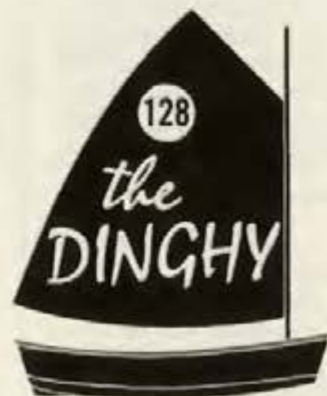

SMBYC Summer Regatta

Among highlights of this year's annual Summer Regatta on August 9 and 10, hosted by the 11 member YC's of the Association of Santa Monica Bay Yacht Clubs, will be several National Championship events.

Classes holding such Championships will include: Columbia Challenger, Columbia 26, Venture 21, Pelican, San Clemente 23, and Santana 27. For the last two classes named this will mark the first Nationals to be held anywhere.

Other special races within the overall ASMBYC Regatta will include a Pacific Multihull Association World Championship event at Malibu YC, and a deluded reckoning event for power boats sponsored by Del Rey YC.

"Going to sea" is fun; it's adventurous. It's an escape from the pressures of the landlubber's life ashore, but it also can be dangerous for the unprepared, ill-advised, and improperly equipped. Here are a few tips on preparation for your boating trip that may save you embarrassment of returning to your slip or boat trailer at "the end of a tow line," or the worst penalty of carelessness — "death or injury."

Whether you are a "skipper" or a guest, you relax and enjoy yourself more knowing that rescue agencies stand ready to assist in emergencies. However, the old saying goes, "an ounce of prevention is better than a pound of cure." So, a visit to the local Harbormaster's or Harbor Patrol office before departing the harbor for a cruise on the ocean, or just cruising inside the harbor may provide that ounce of information or advice about rules, regulations, and local knowledge of the area that will prevent having to take the cure.

WEATHER

Weather is a prime factor in going to sea. Experienced boaters respect it and devote time to the study of forecasts and weather effect. Enjoy the prevailing good weather with which we are blessed, but don't ignore the storm warnings. Check the weather stations at Marina del Rey's Administration

The first ferro-cement sailboat to be built and launched at Marina del Rey will probably be the H-28 prototype now being constructed by sailmaker Ben Breeding.

While cement boats are not recent in concept (examples of them having been around for more than 100 years), new construction methods and materials have lately begun to bring a new excitement into the future prospects for them.

A major key to the interest in cement boatbuilding — particularly for the amateur boatbuilder — is its cost. As an example of this, Breeding estimates the total materials cost for his 28' hull and deck at about \$300. Other factors contributing to the current interest are

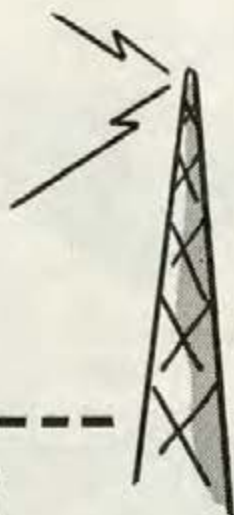

Building, the end of Santa Monica Pier, and at Redondo Beach, or whichever harbor you are in; if you see the "big red pennant" flying, it means "don't go to sea in a small boat."

— BE WEATHER CONSCIOUS — KNOW THE RULES

Laws governing the operation of your boat encompass the same common sense rules you observe while driving your automobile. In general for every harbor, they relate to speed, right of way, proper licensing, the avoidance of unusual noises, prevention of pollution and littering the waters with debris, reckless or negligent operation, or operation under the influence of alcohol.

OPERATION

Boating courtesy: A boatman may be skilled in the operation of his craft; he may know the "rules of the road;" he may be familiar with navigation; but if he operates his boat in a manner that will cause annoyance, discomfort, and danger to others, then he is *not* a good boatman. Remember that you are responsible for any damage or injury

your boat may cause other craft, persons, or property. High speed and sharp turns are frequent causes of accidents. Remember your wake, even in an outboard, can cause serious damage — and for that *you are responsible*.

Keep away from swimmers; slow down when passing fishing vessels. Keep out of the way of tows and larger vessels. Know navigational aids. Keep right in narrow channels; maintain position and avoid passing. Round the buoys like a seaman; short cuts inside the buoys are short cuts to trouble.

ENFORCEMENT

Within any harbor anywhere you can bet there will be a maximum speed limit and stringently enforced. Your Harbor Patrols usually will have concurrent jurisdiction with Federal, State and marine enforcement officials. Although constantly emphasizing the educational and safety aspects of safe boating, they must also discharge their responsibility to enforce the law. Enforcement is essential and violations of any Federal, State or local law may subject a boat owner, operator, or passenger to citation or arrest by Harbor Patrol.
