

Living quarters aboard include a main salon, two staterooms (one with




Col Challenger Fleet Plans Active Summer




Boatowners Warned

Boatowners were recently warned by Ed Nichols, executive director of the Southern California Marine Association, that Assembly Bill 2221 introduced into the State Legislature last April 2 by Assemblyman Pete Schabarum of Glendora will, among other things, double the cost of boat registration in California.

"The boatowner will not only have to pay twice the amount paid in the past, but instead of renewing every three years he will have to do so every year," according to Nichols. "Speaking as a private boatowner and not an official of SCMA," said Nichols, "this appears to me to be just another government tax on the boating citizenry of this state, even though it is labeled as a registration fee. We are already paying every kind of tax there is on our boats, and now the state wants more. Where does it end?"
